Did you know...

The BRM P15 was the first F1 race-winning car, built in 1949. In 1950 it took the victory at F1's Goodwood meet (not part of the world championship but still an F1 event) when Reg Parnell beat Prince Bira's Maserati by nearly 14 seconds in a 20-minute race.
