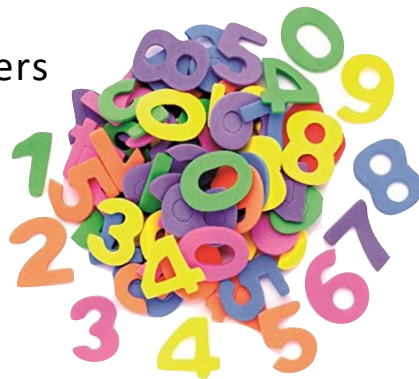
Did you know...
