

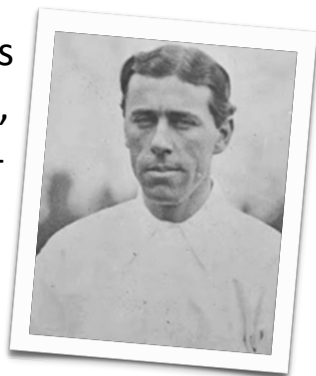

On this day...

in 1907, Australian tennis player, Norman Brookes, became the first non-Englishman and left-hander to win Wimbledon. He beat Arthur Gore 6-4, 6-2, 6-2.



Did you know...



54,250 tennis balls are used during the Championships period at Wimbledon. At start of each day, 48 tins of tennis balls are taken onto Centre and No. 1 Courts and 24 on all outside courts. Tennis balls were not always yellow.
