We used this story to launch a host of imaginative challenges over the course of the week that the children loved taking part in. One of our activities was making predictions about what would happen when we added white flowers to water with food colouring. 
All the children are budding scientists in Stort class! The children explored the reaction of bicarbonate soda mixing with vinegar and were amazed when they saw it 'explode'! They used food colouring to make different bubbly mixtures and showed great fine motor skills using the pipettes for this activity.



Welcome back to the last half term of this academic year. We begin our last topic of 'Change is different but it is good.' In the last seven weeks, children will talk about seasonal changes, summer family outings such as seaside trips, camping etc. Lastly, some children will explore the concept of transition and changes as they've become more grown up and begin their school journey into Reception.

This week's focus book of 'You choose' by Pippa Goodhart, was a valuable discussion prompt for children to discuss their favourite things.

The children answered various question personal to them such as, If you could go anywhere, where would you go? Who would you like as a friend? What would you eat? What would you do for fun?



What does it mean, wheels or wings? What does perhaps mean? What does it mean to have fun? What happens when you snooze?

family, friends, home, choose, travel, hungry, pet, job




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
