<p>English</p> <p><u>Simple retelling of a narrative</u> In this unit, children will explore the well known story 'The tortoise and the hare'. They will create a story map to plot the main events, explore a range of descriptive devices and use the third person to re-tell the story in their own words.</p> <p><u>Poetry -Pattern and Rhyme</u> Children will identify patterns and rhymes in poems. Exploring syllables and rhyming words before having a go at their own!</p>	<p>Art/DT</p> <p><u>DT: Mechanisms (moving pictures)</u> Children will explore 'sliders' before experimenting with different systems. Once confident in creating a range of simple mechanisms, children will make their own card slider product.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p><u>Being together in Music</u> In Music this term, children will explore a range of different nursery rhymes, learning different melodies and lyrics. Children will discuss how these songs make them feel. They will be introduced to simple conducting cues and learn the terms 'melody' and 'lyrics'.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p><u>Addition and Subtraction (within 10)</u> In this unit, children will be introduced to parts and wholes. They will learn to write number sentences and understand the symbols representing addition, subtraction and equals. They will explore the concept of number bonds within 10 and add or subtract 1-digit and 2 digit numbers to 20.</p> <p><u>Shape</u> Children will learn the names and properties of a range of 2d and 3d shapes. Using vocabulary such as 'sides, vertices and faces'.</p>
<p>Science</p> <p><u>Introduce -Plants including trees</u> In science this half term, children will learn the parts of a plant -exploring in depth their purpose and role. They will learn what a bulb is and explore new vocabulary such as 'germinate' and 'dormant'. We will explore the difference between 'wild' and 'garden' flowers before discussing trees and what makes these different from plants. Children will build on prior knowledge and extend their understanding by working scientifically and asking questions.</p>	<p>Cam Class</p> <p><u>Autumn Term 2</u></p>		<p>PE</p> <p><u>'Hands'</u> Children will develop their 'dribbling' skills as well as their passing and receiving techniques in order to keep possession of the ball. They will play games involving 'attackers' and 'defending' where they can practise different skills and team work skills. Children will also continue with Yoga on a Monday Afternoon.</p>
	<p>PSHE</p> <p><u>Celebrating difference</u> In this topic, children will learn to celebrate everyone! They will learn how to use kind words, give & receive compliments and stand up for themselves. Children will learn the terms 'stereotypes' and 'assumptions' before exploring some ways in which boys and girls are both similar and different.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>In this unit the children will be learning about Continents, Oceans, UK countries, Capital Cities and surrounding seas.</p>
