Dear Families,

During the Spring term our values were Respect and Integrity.

At Avanti we have discussed what these values mean to the children and the different ways they can show respect and integrity at home and at school.

We embed the values by linking them to all our lessons within the curriculum, assemblies and our golden expectations at school.

In PSHE lessons we have been doing a lot of work on 'Anti-Bullying'. All year groups looked at different aspects of bullying. Early years focused on kindness, Key Stage 1 participated in performance workshops and key Stage 2 focused on cyber bullying and performed an assembly for the school.

As a school we set a competition to design an Anti Bullying poster. **Our winning entries are displayed overleaf.**

We also ran a workshop for parents to ensure they felt fully supported and informed regarding Anti-Bullying. We had a very good response and parental feedback was positive, they felt that the information given was very clear.

The impact of this project is represented in our recent parent survey, which indicates that 96% of parents agree that their child is happy at school. The survey also showed that 89% of parents felt that the school deals effectively with incidents of racism and bullying effectively. However, 89% for Avanti Court is not good enough, so we are looking at ways to increase this number so that all parents feel the school tackles bullying effectively.
