

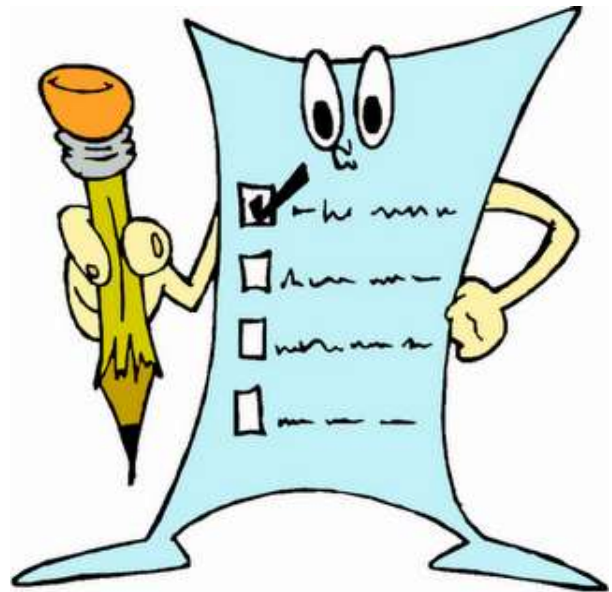

Teach science more	Children across Key Stage 1 and 2 are taught science weekly. As a school we will share more of their learning with you in the form of a newsletter every term so that you can view the learning. Can you give parents a car parking space?	No actions from the school - The school only has enough spaces for staff on site. There are places where you can park such as Sainsbury's and Tesco's which are both a short walk away.			
I am worried about pupil security	No actions needed from the school as site and pupil security is a priority every day. As a school we have 24hour CCTV, which is monitored during the day by our site team. Access into the school is controlled by an entry system. Access into different parts of the school from within are controlled by fob access. All visitors allowed access into the site undergo strict security checks. The school has procedures in place for fire evacuations and for lock down. The school undergoes regular safety audits from within and outside of the trust.
