

Swimming Progress

Swimming at Avanti Year 5 2021-2022

All pupils in Year 6 took part in swimming lessons at Fullwell Cross in the Autumn term. By the end of term 56/113 pupils were able to swim 25m.

In addition, 13 pupils successfully completed their Survival Skills certificate.

COVID absence impacted progress for some pupils in Year 6 during the term.

Swimming at Avanti Year 5 2020-2021

All pupils in Year 6 took part in swimming lessons at Fullwell Cross in the summer term. By the end of term 74 pupils were able to swim 25m.

18 pupils successfully completed their Survival Skills certificate.

Due to Covid, swimming lessons did not take place during 2019-2020

Swimming at Avanti Year 5 2018-2019

All pupils in Year 5 took part in swimming lessons at Fullwell Cross in the summer term. By the end of term 67 pupils were able to swim 25m.

4 pupils successfully completed their Survival Skills certificate.

Swimming at Avanti Year 5 2017-2018

All pupils in Year 5 took part in swimming lessons at Fullwell Cross in the summer term. Out of 4 classes 21 pupils did not reach the expected standard and as part of our sports funding action plan we will secure partly funded places for catch up sessions at Tritons Swim School/Fullwell Cross.

Swimming at Avanti Year 5 2016-2017

All pupils in Year 5 took part in swimming lessons at Fullwell Cross. Out of 1 class 26 pupils in the cohort can swim competently over at least 25m, use a range of strokes effectively and perform safe self-rescue. 4 pupils did not reach the expected standard and as part of our sports funding action plan we secured places for catch up sessions at Tritons Swim School.
