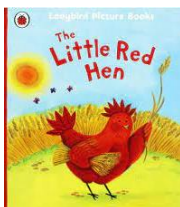
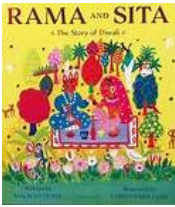


Autumn Term 2 Topic is: Traditional Tales

Key texts



Writing

We want all of our children to be creative writers. Learning to re-tell stories is a part of this learning curve. Going to the local library and sharing a book with your child, and inspiring them with new stories will help them with this.

Now that they know some sounds, encourage them to have a go at writing. Hearing the initial sounds is the first stage of this e.g., 'b' in biscuit. Encourage your child to write for purpose e.g., through writing letters to people they love, shopping lists, and posters about things they like. This will help them on their writing journey!

Other home learning ideas

Go for a nature walk to the forest to learn about the changes from Autumn to Winter.

Go for a local walk- look at houses and the materials that are used to make them.

Reading

Most children will now know the sounds. Please work with them at home to help them say these sounds at speed.

sun, gas.



Red words:

Red words are words you cannot sound out. Help your child to recognise these words. Remember do not sound out, just say it!
