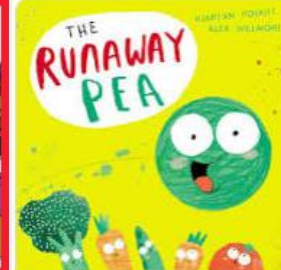
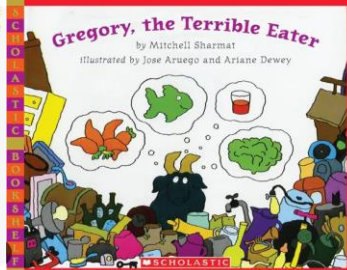
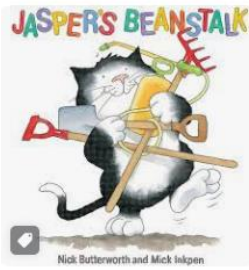


## Nursery Class

### Physical Development

We want all our children to develop their gross and fine motor skills. Taking your child to the park and challenging them to climb and be active is all part of developing their core strength.

Letting children have a go at using a knife to cut up fruit to make a fruit salad at home.

To develop your child's fine motor skills allow them to explore different writing medias, help with hanging up the washing and even using a knife and fork at home. At school we have begun to learn some letter sounds and their formation. Remember to use the Read Write Inc phrases to help them form their letters.



### Communication and Language

Speaking and listening is the key to everything. Having conversations about your child's day, looking at old photos are all a great way of developing quality conversations.



#### This term consider:

Looking at what is healthy food and how it helps us to grow and become bigger and stronger and gut health.

Making a fruit salad at home and talking about how important it is to have a mixture of fruit and salad in a daily diet.

We are looking at where different fruit and vegetables come from around the world.

Planting cress seeds at home and talking about how different fruit and vegetables grow.

### Other home learning ideas

Going on a number hunt- looking at numbers in the real world

Explore writing for meaning- writing lists of ingredients for making a fruit salad.

#### Home learning project

Using your child's favourite fruit to make a fruit salad at home together.

Looking at where in the world your child's favourite fruit and or vegetable comes from.

Next term we are looking at the key values Respect and Self- discipline, empathy and courage.
