- It can be a character from your favourite fairytale, myth or legend!

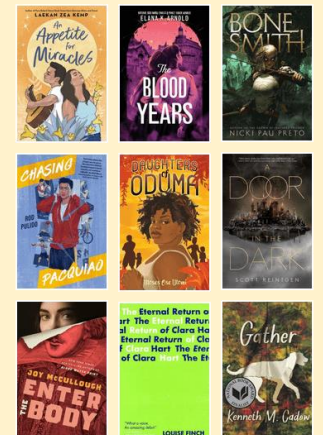
The choice is yours.

You can do one, two, three or all the tasks.

All tasks must have your full name, tutor group and English teacher's name on.
They can be handed to Mr Burlinski directly or given to your English teacher.

Task 1:

Create a cover and blurb for your favourite story

- Prize for the winner
- Achievement points for everyone who enters
- House points will be awarded for the following:
 - ⇒ 1st place: 60 points
 - ⇒ 2nd place: 40 points
 - ⇒ 3rd place: 30 points
 - ⇒ 4th place: 20 points
 - ⇒ 5th place: 10 points

Task 2:

Write a description of your favourite character from a book and draw them
