Key Expectations

- All pupils to arrive to school and their lessons ready to learn
 - Arrive at school by 8:15am to ensure you are in your form room for 8:20am
 - Arrive to your lessons on time; don't lap the corridors go straight in!
- Uniform and equipment expectations (form tutor checks)
 - Grey or charcoal (not black) trousers/skirts
 - Correct shoes; not boots/trainers
 - No make up/jewellery
 - Blazers



Key Expectations


- One-way system and the areas that are out of bounds at lunch
 - Move in a clockwise direction around the building.
 - Walk on the right.
 - Drama/Music/DT corridor and Art/PE corridor out of bounds at lunch.
 - First floor corridors out of bounds at lunch. Access only to the library.
 - Second floor corridors out of bounds at lunch.
- Break and lunch time food should only be eaten in the dining hall or outside seating.
 - Help reduce litter by not bringing food onto the playground and MUGA.



Key Updates: Toilets and Vandalism

- The toilets have been repainted over the holidays and soap dispensers repaired.
 - Only one person in a cubicle at a time. Use student designated toilets, not staff toilets.
 - Vandalism will be sanctioned with an automatic C4 1h detention with HOY , and parents will be contacted.
 - Repeat vandalism will be sanctioned with an 1h Friday detention with the principal, and parents will be contacted and asked to pay for repairs/repainting.
- Student council will be consulted on what else we can do to make the toilets a more pleasant experience at school.
- It is your school environment you need to look after it!

Key Updates: Mobile Phones and SMART Watches



- Mobile phones and SMART watches should be stored in lockers (preferable) or in school bags. They should NOT be stored in pupil's blazers.
- Mobile phones should be turned OFF upon entry to the school gates.
- We do not allow the wearing of SMART watches on school premises.



Key Updates: Mobile Phones and SMART Watches (Sanctions)

- Pupils who break the rules will have the following sanctions issued:
 - Mobile phone or SMART watch confiscated by school staff, to be securely stored with our admin team until a <u>parent</u> is able to collect.
 - Automatic C3 detention will be issued.
 - Repeated infringements may result in requesting the mobile phone or SMART watch not be bought into school or held with our admin staff throughout the day. Other sanctions may be applied as per our current behaviour policy.



Tutor Actions

• Uniform check:

- Blazers, correct shoes, correct trousers/skirts, no make-up or jewellery
- Email home to parents for anyone with incorrect uniform

• Mobile phone check:

- Encourage pupils to put mobile phones in lockers
- If in school bag, check that phones are turned OFF
- No mobile phones to be in blazer pockets
- You should be responsible for your own belongings. Do not share lockers or ask other people to look after your possessions.
