



After some top tips to help you save money on food?

- Plan your meals buying food for the week helps to cut down on impulse buys
- If you can, buy food like rice and pasta in bulk it is often much cheaper per 100g than smaller bags
- 'Reduced to clear' foods can help save money but think about when/how you'll eat them before you buy
- Buy what you need buying loose fruit & veg can help you save money by buying only what you are going to eat




Here we are using metre sticks and rulers to measure using centimetres and metres. We even know that when we write it, we can use cm and m!






In science we carried out an experiment on the importance of joints. In art we sketched Bronze Age pots in preparation for making our own from clay.






We have been continuing our research into food packaging in D&T by making our own nets and deciding which foods might be packed in these shapes.
