In Literacy we have been learning lots of stories including the gingerbread man. We even made our own gingerbread men. We have also been developing our simple sentence writing. We listened to the story of the Gingerbread Man. We enjoyed it so much that we cut out and coloured our own gingerbread people and we made, cooked, decorated and ate our very own tasty gingerbread people. We have continued with our literacy and numeracy work. We read the recipes and written our own instructions for making gingerbread. We counted and measured the ingredients and observed the changes to the dough. In our numeracy we have been looking at numbers to 20, counting on and back and identifying one more/less. As part of our work on transport and travel we

In Maths we have been learning all about money. We can now recognise coins and notes. Maybe the children can help you buy something this half term!



In Art we have found out about Inuksuks and have created our own versions using clay.



In Science we have been learning about the parts of a flower and tree. We also know the difference between wild and garden plants.





LILY CLASS

This term in Science, we have been learning all about plants. We have hunted for wildflowers and looked at the parts of a tree.







In History, we have been learning about Mary Anning and her amazing work with fossils.

In Art we have been learning about inuksuk art and the work of Kenojuak Ashevak. She is one of the most well-known Canadian Inuit artists.





In Maths, we have been learning all about money. The children have been buying their snacks for break each day and just like in the real supermarkets, the prices just keep changing!

In Art, we took inspiration from the art of the Indigenous people of Australia. We combined these ideas with sculpture, creating threedimensional forms decorated with dot patterns.
