#### EYFS at Avanti

Our EYFS curriculum at Avanti is a broad and balanced curriculum which places great emphasis on all children developing independence, confidence, creativity, curiosity, knowledge and understanding.

We provide a balance of child initiated and teacher led activities and provide meaningful, practical and multisensory learning experiences which aim to fully engage children each day and help them to develop ownership of their own learning.

#### EYFS at Avanti is presented in three ways...



**1. Foundational knowledge:** what pupils should know and be able to do throughout the EYFS and how this will support their development and prepare them for Key Stage 1




**2. Opportunities and experiences:** how this foundational knowledge can be learnt through play and through guided activities that will allow pupils to explore, experiment with and think hard about new and important concepts



# Home Visits and Settling in

The class teachers will be making home visits to families between 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> September. Children will be starting school on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September and the timetable will be:

- Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September 8.30-12.00 (going home before lunch)
- Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> September 8.30-12.00 (going home before lunch)
- Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> September 8.30-13.00 (going home after lunch)
- Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> September 8.30-13.00 (going home after lunch)
- Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September 8.30-15.15 (a full day)

The following week from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September, the children will be in full-time. The school day is from 8.30 to 15.15.



# Lunch (12 - 1)

Children in EYFS are entitled to Universal Free School Meals and so from Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> September, they will be entitled to a free school meal. Please ensure that when you complete the Admissions form so that you let us know of any allergies or dietary requirements. All food served is Vegetarian, but Vegan options are also available.

In September, we will be able to add parents to ParentPay, which is the platform we use for ordering school meals. We ask that families pre-order at least 48 hours in advance, to ensure that the kitchen can prepare the correct amount of food and reduce food waste.



We update the Govinda's menu on our website and there are 3 options every day on a 3-week rotating basis, and you can always find out most recent menu on our website.



Our uniform gives us a sense of community and pride in our school and our expectation is that all children come to school in the Avanti Gardens uniform.
