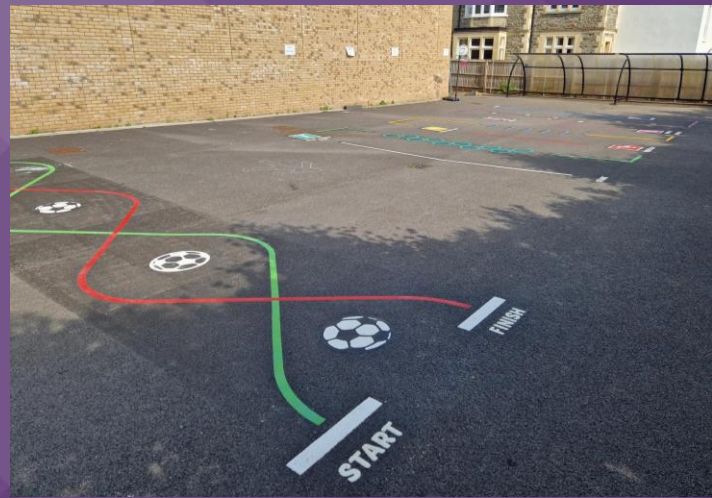

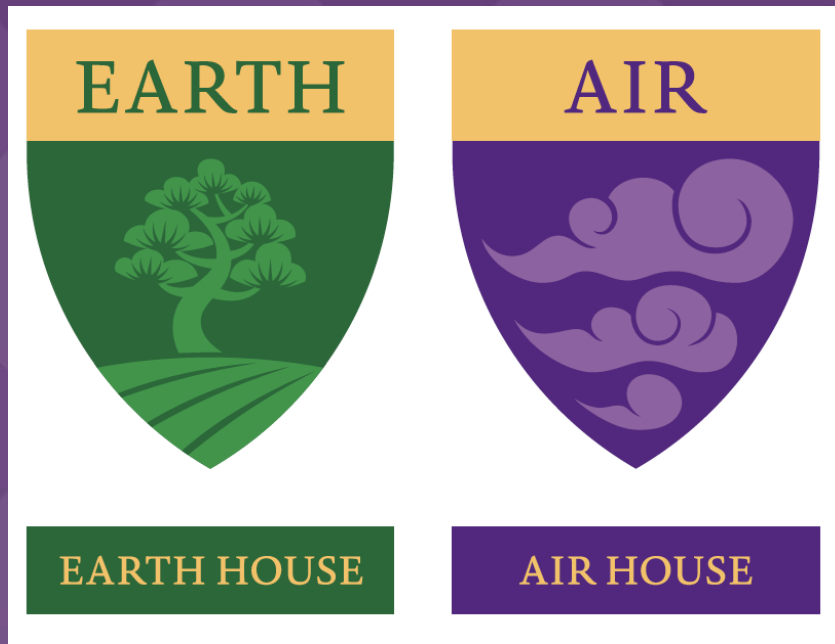
Exciting Site Developments

From September we will have four new house names which are **Earth House**, **Air House**, **Fire House** and **Water House**.

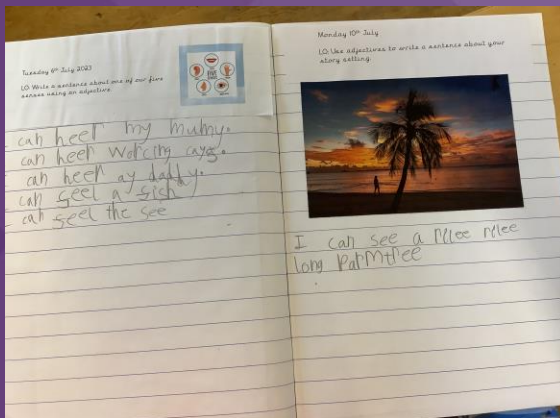


We will be having lots of exciting house events next year outside of our annual sports day.

LAVENDER CLASS

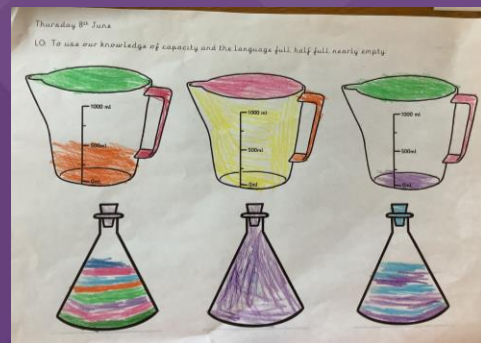

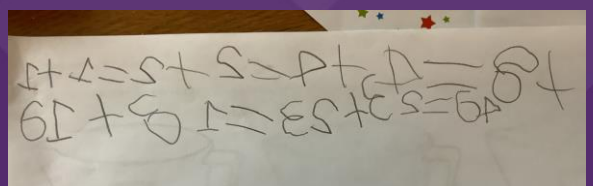


In Literacy we have been presenting our best writing! We have been writing facts, descriptive sentences and even our own poems.

We had great fun building an obstacle course in our playground and we tired ourselves out using it. It was exhausting but great fun!

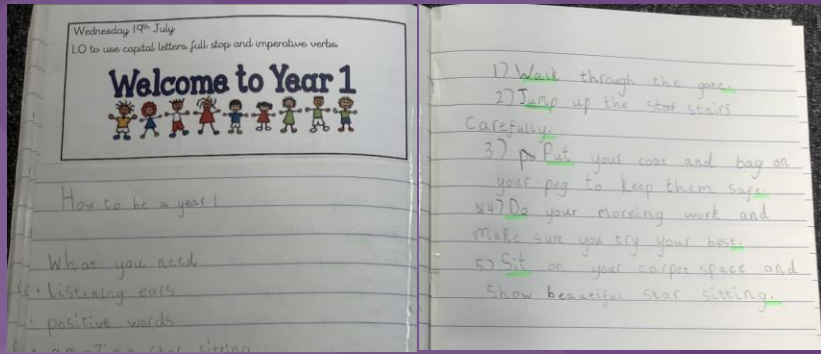
DAFFODIL CLASS



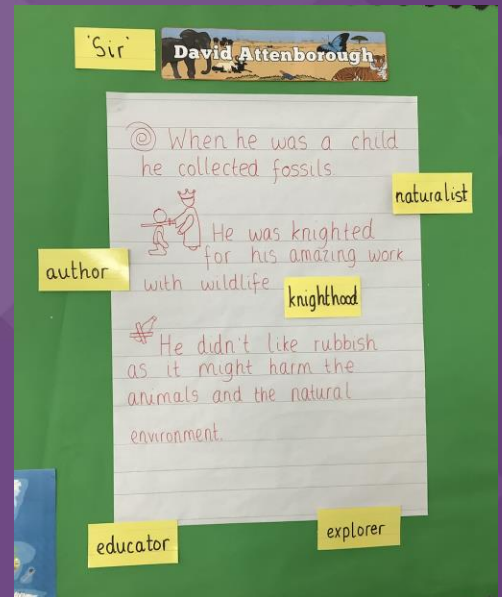
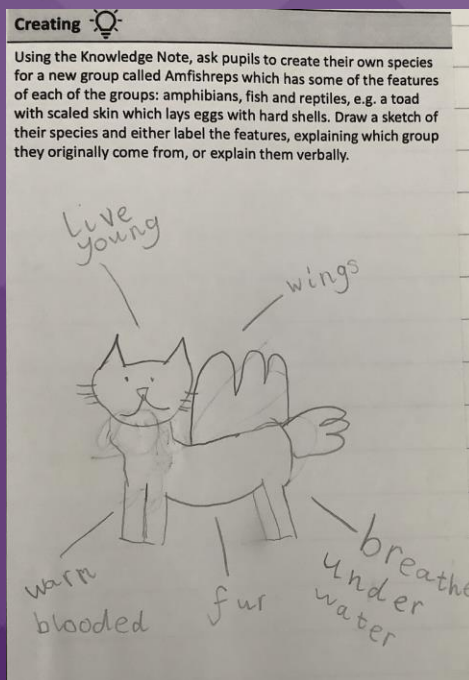
We had fun learning all about a balanced diet and making rainbow wraps using a variety of cooking tools in DT.

In Science we have been learning about the different groups of animals such as reptiles and mammals. We enjoyed creating our own animal using a combination of the different animal groups.

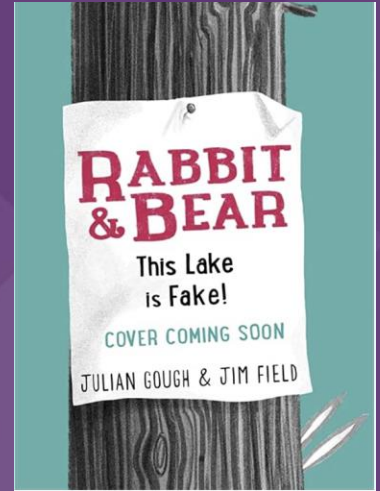


In History, we have been looking at David Attenborough and his achievements. The children enjoyed watching some of his documentaries.



LILY CLASS

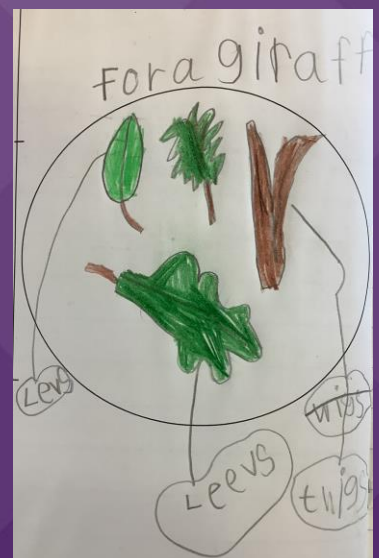
We have been thoroughly enjoying reading the Bear and Rabbit books this term. We are very excited about the new book called coming out.



The children absolutely loved DT this term. We have learnt all about colours, textures and what is healthy. Especially when they made their rainbow wraps.



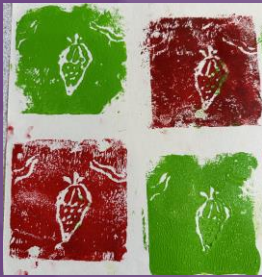
In science we have been learning all about animals and their features. We have also learnt about their diets and about our senses.

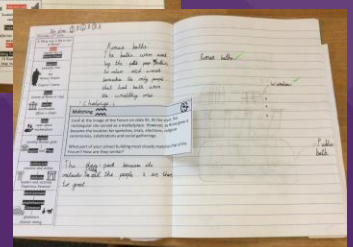


IRIS CLASS

In History we explored the Romans. In Geography we looked at map reading.

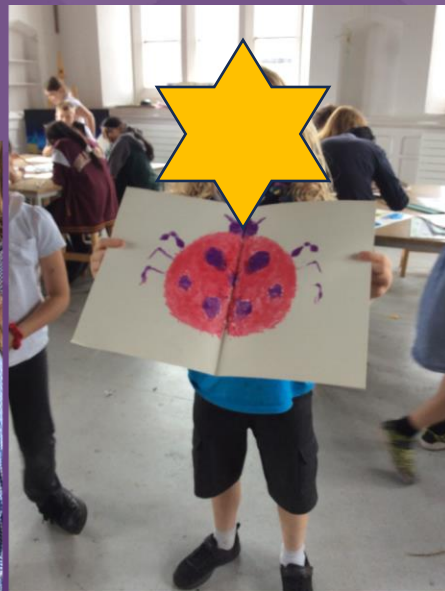
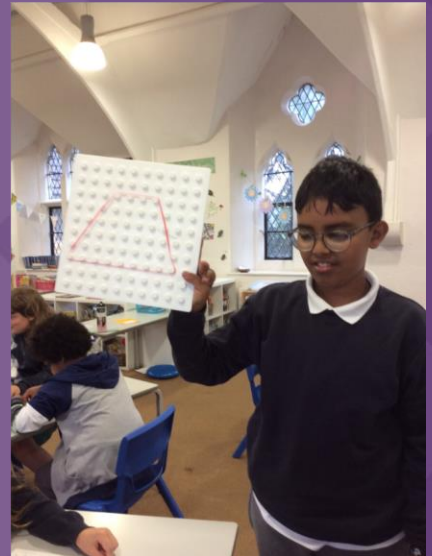
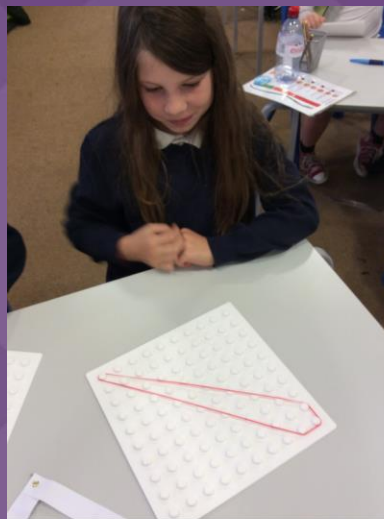


In Science we have been recapping on topics explored this term such as bodies, physical health and rocks.



FOXGLOVE CLASS

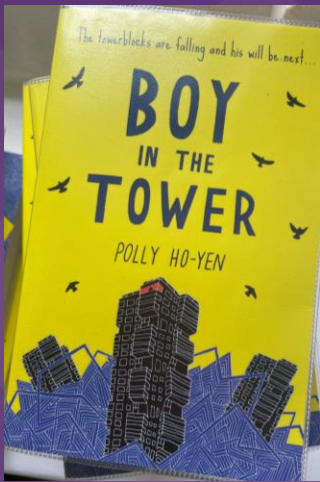
In art and DT, we started by taking inspiration from henna and mandala designs. We then used this to sew our own mandala themed patches using running and fern stitches.



In maths we have been learning about shapes and lines of symmetry. We took our knowledge to the art room to create symmetrical paintings!

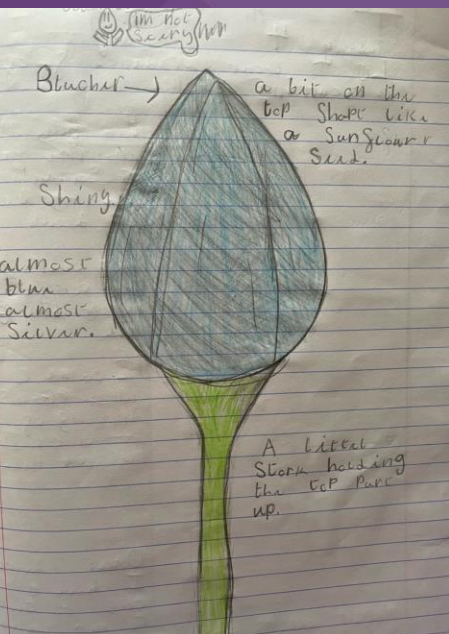


JASMINE CLASS
