Open-Classroom – Stay and Read Event – Friday 22nd September 2023

We would like to welcome you all to our first open-classroom event of this academic year which will take place from **2.45pm until 3.30pm** on **Friday 22nd September**. This will provide you with an opportunity to visit your child's classroom, read with your child, and meet their teacher for this academic year. We would stress that this event is not an additional parents evening and any specific questions regarding your child's learning would be better posed at another time.

The main school gates on Oldbury court Road will open at **2.45pm** and you will have a chance to walk the route that your child walks to their classroom each morning, where they will be waiting to greet you and read with you.

For this day only <u>all children will be collected from this classroom</u>, however no child will be able to be dismissed to parents until the normal time of **3.15pm**. Parents who have children in multiple classes will be able to walk between their children's classes, but children must remain in their own classroom until the end of the day. All parents and children will need to make their way offsite by **3.30pm** when the school will need to be locked.

There will be plenty of members of staff on-site helping to direct parents to and between classes. We understand that not all parents/carers may be able to attend this event however we intend this to be the first of many opportunities for parents to celebrate the fantastic work that the children at Avanti Gardens are producing as part of their exciting curriculum offer.
