Location, Location, Location...


Once the Avanti 'Learning Village' is complete, Avanti Grange will sit proudly between our two primaries. The road linking the three schools is built (not yet open) This will provide easy access from Stortford Fields, St. Michael's Hurst, as well as the whole of Bishops Stortford and the surrounding villages.

To make access even easier the 510-Bus Route will continue to stop just a 3min walk from the school gates. Bike shelters will be available, and we will have a drop off system in operation as well. We look forward to greeting you at the school gate each morning, whatever the weather!


What attracted you to Avanti Grange?


Avanti Quest
