BYOD – Bring Your Own Device

Avanti Grange will be a 'Bring Your Own Device' school. The use of personal devices at school deepens learning. It allows learning which is personalised and student-centred, helps to develop modern teaching and learning practices, and fosters digital literacy, fluency and social responsibility in a safe environment.

Students will be expected to bring a laptop-style device with a physical keyboard. Tablet devices and smartphones have limited practical use and will not be allowed in lessons.

We are planning for about 30% of lessons to have some element of device use, this may be for part or all of the lesson. Further advice about the type of device in which to invest in will be provided at our Parents Transition Evening on the 7th July.

Microsoft 365

We will also be an Office 365 school, students will be taught and then expected to use Office 365 programmes when asked. Students will also have the opportunity to use a range of subject specific software in lessons. Microsoft Teams will be used for sharing resources and assignments as well as remote learning, if it should be required in the



future.





Ukraine
