Specific collection bins will be placed in the playground for children to put their fruit peels in at snack time and a large collection bin in our Govinda's kitchen. These will be emptied into a larger compost bin already positioned in our Sensory Garden, by Mr Craig with the help of our Eco Committee (pictured standing up). It will be a great on-going green project all children can get involved in and we look forward to next year when we will hopefully be able to use our own school made compost to grow our plants!
