

Curriculum Information Sheet Autumn Term 1 2019-2020

Class: Optimistic Owl & Courageous Canaries Year 6

THEMES	This term our learning is based around the theme of War - Then and Now
ENGLISH	During the half term we will be studying novels and stories by significant children's authors. Key text: The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas by John Boyne.
writing	 We will be focusing on: Writing linked to the key text and class theme (War - then and now) Historical narrative, writing stories from the viewpoints of different characters Fictional narrative writing techniques Vocabulary, Spelling, Grammar, Reading and Comprehension Modal verbs Relative clauses Using a colon to introduce a list Using semi-colons Fronted adverbials Prefixes and suffixes Use of dictionaries and thesauruses
	Handwriting To write legibly, fluently and with increasing speed. Spelling All children will be given weekly spellings to practise based on the Year 5 and 6 in Appendix 2 SPAG curriculum and they will be tested on these.
MATHS	Each week the children will be challenged on key areas of the Year 6 maths curriculum. The principal focus of mathematics teaching in upper key stage 2 is to ensure that pupils extend their understanding of the number system and place value to include larger integers. This should develop the connections that pupils make between addition and subtraction, multiplication and division with decimals and negative numbers. We will be developing their skills in: Securing number facts, place value and relationships Problem solving using different operations Adding and subtracting using mental strategies. Multiplying and dividing numbers using various mental and written methods Measuring and calculating length Calculate area and perimeter using a formula
	 Reading and presenting information on charts, pictograms, carol diagrams, Venn diagrams, tally charts and line graphs. Calculate mean We will be learning about Evolution and Inheritance for our half term Science topic.
SCIENCE	There is an emphasis on asking scientific questions, developing investigative skills and writing up investigations. For our topic on Evolution and Inheritance we will be learning about:



- How living things have changed overtime
- How offspring vary from their parents
- Describing how animals and plants adapt to suit their environment

The principal focus of Science teaching in upper Key Stage 2 is to enable pupils to broaden their scientific view of the world around them. They will do this through enquiries, taking measurements, recording data and results, exploring, talking about, testing, developing ideas about everyday phenomena and the relationships between living things and familiar environments. They will begin to develop their ideas about functions, relationships and interactions.

TOPIC WORK (History)

Our history topic for this half term is War - then and now

It is important that the children develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of British, local and world history, establishing clear narratives within and across the periods they study.



Throughout their History learning this half term we will be focusing on:

- The impact of WW1 & 2 on London.
- The 'Holocaust'
- Links to other countries and occupations of those countries.
- Extended chronological study- significant turning point in British history- the battle of Britain
