Clues and some rules!
Strictly speaking, the suffixes are – ion and –ian. Clues about whether to put t , s , ss or c before these suffixes often come from the last letter or letters of the root word.
 -tion is the most common spelling. It is used if the root word ends in t or te. -ssion is used if the root word ends in ss or -mit.
 -sion is used if the root word ends in d or se. Exceptions: attend – attention, intend – intention. -cian is used if the root word ends in c or cs.

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
