Where can the animal be found?

(It's natural habitat eg high in the trees, rivers etc)

What does the animal eat? (It's diet)

What does it look like? (It's appearance - draw it!)

Is it endemic to Madagascar? (Is it only found in Madagascar?)

Are there many of the species living in Madagascar? (Population)
