On Tuesday 3rd March 2020 2 professional bankers from Natwest had kindly arranged a presentation for us to explain about the strategies used for a successful Business First they talked about what **money** is-money is something that you can exchange for a **product** and **services**. What is a **business**? A business is when a person or organization sells goods and provides service in exchange for money which is called a **Profit.** 

<u> Making our own Business</u>

The first activity was our own smoothie stall. We had to give our group a name which was **Smoothilicious**. Sadly we made a loss and no profit as 20 - 10 =10 so we made a loss of £10.My group kept on doing trial and error until we reached a price that was £2 and 40 people came to buy it and as 2×40=80 and 80 - 20= 60 so we made a profit of £60!
