

Dear EYFS Parents,

Due to the EYFS bubble having to self-isolate, we will be supporting our pupils via online learning platforms. EYFS staff will be working from home to ensure children are still able to engage in meaningful learning throughout this time.

**Please see details of what you can expect from us below:**

- EYFS will have a weekly learning menu for parents to access to support children. This can be found on the school website (AHP-pupils-reception- homework)
- Daily interaction with the EYFS children via Zoom. These sessions will vary between phonics/ maths/ music/ circle time/ show and tell, etc. These sessions may be for the whole class or small groups; you will receive a timetable via email and Tapestry memo.
- Class teachers and LSAs will be available to answer any questions parents may ask on Tapestry in order to better support learning at home.
- We will leave feedback/comments/ key info/ zoom information on Tapestry (memo page- please continue to check this) and on the school website (AHP-pupils-reception).
- PowerPoints and other digital resources from Zoom sessions will be uploaded to the website for parents to access with children.

**We kindly ask that parents continue to do the following:**

- Check Tapestry daily for memos and important information.
- Check the school website regularly (AHP-pupils-reception).
- Communicate with us via Tapestry or email the office and they will forward to us.
- Attempt to complete as much of the learning menu with children as possible.
- **Upload evidence (pictures/videos/comments) of children's home learning on Tapestry regularly.**

Thank you for supporting your child through this difficult time. We will endeavor to do our best as we navigate through online teaching and learning; thank you for being patient throughout this process.

Scheduled Zoom parent meetings will continue as planned.
