




Our new story is Jack and the Beanstalk

Jack and the Beanstalk



The next morning, Jack looked out of the window. A giant beanstalk had grown in the garden!


> Oh wow! It's a giant green beanstalk. I wonder what <u>could be up there?</u>


What do you think will be up there?


Jack decided to go inside; all the furniture was huge!

Do you think Jack is being respectful?


Should he be stealing?

How will the giant feel?


As Jack ran the harp cried, "Help, master!"




The giant woke up and called, "Fee, Fi, Fo, Fum, I smell the blood of an Englishman!" He chased Jack to the top of the beanstalk.




Jack climbed down the beanstalk and the giant followed him.








The giant fell and crashed to the ground. He was never seen again.

<u>Wednesday</u> - Describe main characters. Use phonics and role play to describe characters

Main activity for Thursday and Friday (Can continue over the weekend too): Get creative and create story props, puppets etc for your own role play Use the props in your role play

<u>Thursday</u> – We will do small group sessions where children can show off their work and role play to the teachers (We will contact you through Tapestry to let you know when your child's session will be) We would like you to join the small group sessions dressed up as one of the characters, you can even use a Zoom filter or virtual background. We can pretend to be our characters.

- We will select 2 children to present their work to Miss Patel and Mrs Joshi next week through Zoom (11th Feb at 3:30pm we will contact you separately).
- We will also select 2 pieces of video evidence from Tapestry to be shared with the rest of the school.
