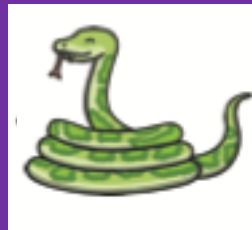


What is rhyming?

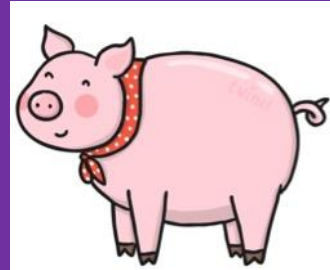

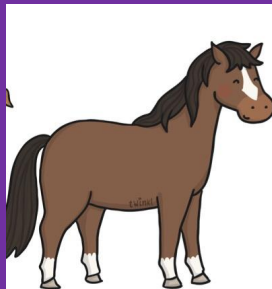
