

***Reception Spring Term Week 2 Learning Menu – Laughing Ladybirds and Busy Bees***

Below is a general overview of activities for the week. Parents can use these ideas or activities to enhance home learning. We will endeavour to upload different activities and ideas each week based on our ‘topic’ learning. If your child is leaving early with their older sibling, they can also try the below activities at home. This can be used as ‘homework’ but this is not compulsory. If your child does complete/engage in any of the below activities, these do not need to be ‘handed in’, however you are more than welcome to start uploading evidence of their learning on Tapestry. If you are unsure of how to access Tapestry please ask class teachers, we will attempt to help you any way we can. Use the below as a ‘menu’ of learning; pick and choose what your child would like to do. Remember to keep learning fun, active and hands on! Be as creative as possible!

**Practise rhyming with your child. Encourage your child to continue a rhyming string. Extension: Think of words that rhyme with the characters from our focus story; The Gingerbread Man. Use your phonics to write the rhyming words. Please upload this evidence.**

Order numbers backwards 10-0</li> <li>• Make simple comparisons between amounts.</li> <li>• What happens if you add the amounts together?</li> <li>• How do you write that as a number sentence?</li> <li>• Solve word problems (worksheet attached)</li> <li>• Practise one more and one less using objects</li> <li>• Can you write those problems as number sentences?</li> <li>• Practise 2 less and 2 more</li> <li>• Practise some simple subtraction and addition using objects and number lines.</li> <li>• Practise one more and one less using number lines.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create rhyming words for the characters in the Gingerbread man story</li> <li>• Practise alliterations and rhyming</li> <li>• Identify rhymes in traditional nursery rhymes.</li> <li>• Create alliterations for the characters from the story</li> <li>• Match rhyming words (worksheets)</li> </ul>
