

# Year 1 Spellings (Autumn 2 – November 2024)

Dear year 1 parents,

Please see the spellings below which need to be learnt for the children's weekly homework. They will be tested every Friday as per the table below. We have given the spellings for the whole half term as we know some parents are keen to work ahead but please note that we will not give further spellings this half term.

Please help your child to compose exciting sentences using the weekly spelling words, which are grammatically correct and encourage them to use the correct tense and punctuation. The children should try to come up with their own sentences, but some may need guidance from yourselves. Please discuss ideas with them as this will encourage them in this regard. The sentences should be photographed and uploaded onto Tapestry on a weekly basis.

It is important that children do not just 'memorise' the spellings but develop their understanding of the phonic sounds, decoding and blending, to enhance their reading, spelling, and writing. One essential way of teaching them is to use sound buttons.

For example, the word **sheep** is spelt using the sounds **sh-ee-p**, the word **visit** is spelt using the sounds **v-i-s-i-t**, etc.

- Write the words on pieces of card and make funny sentences out of them this helps with word order in sentences.
