Essentials

Children should have their book bags in school every day (not back packs or other school bag). This should contain their reading books and home reading record books.

Reading at home

- Please ensure you read with your child daily. Check that your child is using their phonics to sound out words.
- Encourage them to read HFW from sight.
- Ask them questions to help them understand the text.
 - -Why?
 - What?
 - When?
 - -Who?
 - -How?
- Share your book/magazine/News paper and read with your child
