Today we had our very first 'Coffee Morning' for parents. Thank you to those who attended. It was lovely to meet you on a more personal level and to hear your views on the school; your feedback was valuable.

Three main areas were highlighted:

Homework - We understand the importance of home learning and are looking into a uniformed approach to homework for all year groups.

Emails - I am aware that at times there can be an influx of emails and that this can be overwhelming at times. We are reviewing the number of emails that are being sent to you and will ensure that these are communicated with you on a priority basis. We are considering the possibility of a text messaging service.

Please also be reminded that we employ a 48-hour grace period to reply unless emails are deemed as urgent.

Door open - Our doors open from 8.15-8.25am, however after discussion with some parents and in recognition of the traffic, which often plays a factor, we will keep one of the doors in the main hall open until 8.30am.





If you have any changes/updates please ensure you either enter these into Arbor directly, or, you contact the school office to advise of any changes. As the days are becoming colder, please make sure your child has a coat, hat, scarf and gloves in school as we do still allow the children outside as much as possible for their playtimes. (Please ensure that these items are named.)


