### Curriculum Enrichment

The sustainable developmental goals are revisited throughout the children's learning journey from Reception to Year 6 through the medium of '**Global Citizenship Days**'.

### What is Global Citizenship?

A global citizen is aware of and understands the wider world – and their place in it. They take an active role in their community and work with others to make our planet more peaceful, sustainable and fairer. **Global citizenship** is all about encouraging young people to develop the knowledge, skills and values they need to engage with the world. And it's about the belief that we can all make a difference.

Throughout the academic year, our pupils will focus on a range of the sustainable development goals. Each half-term, the children will have a specific Global Citizenship 'focus day'. On these days, teachers will plan learning experiences and activities that delve deep into the SDG of focus – educating the children about the development goal and what we can all do to raise the profile of the area and what we can do to help those in need. Each year, the children will focus on different development goals so that over the course of three years, each goal will have been a focus point.
