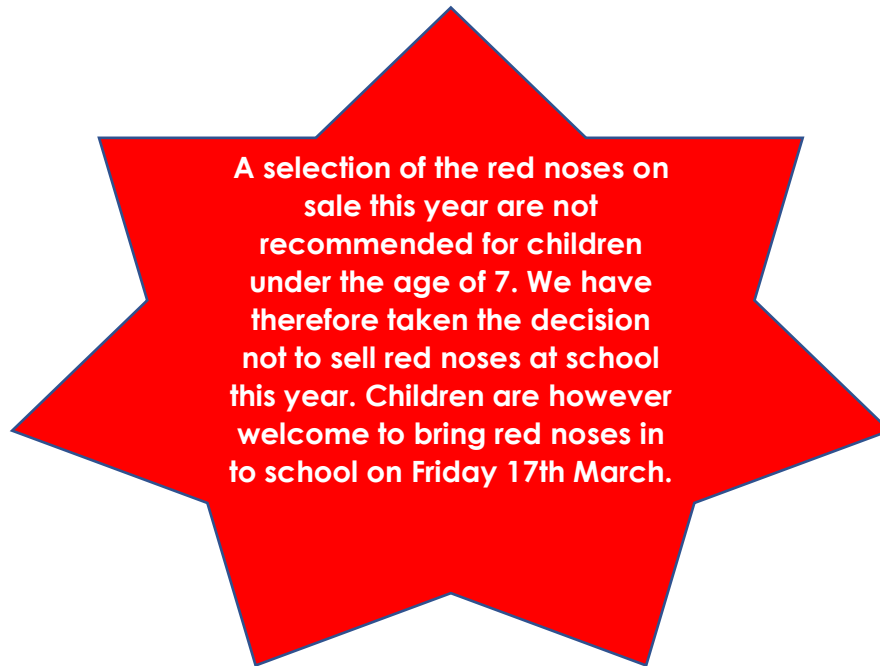
20th-31st March: Big Walk and Wheel- which will include some additional events this year....
