



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#### **GOLEGO CLUB AT AVANTI PARK SCHOOL**

#### MONDAY LEGO CLUB

#### 3:15-4:15 - All ages

We have different themes each week, but children can also freestyle and create whatever they like!. This session is suitable for children of all ages.

#### WEDNESDAY - POKEMON AND LEGO CLUB

What is STEM? - STEM stands for Science, Technology Engineering, and Mathematics. But it's more than that. STEM has grown to represent a unique approach to teaching and learning, one that centres around individual students' learning styles and interests. In this Go Lego STEM club we will use Legos Learning Systems to create an intuitive, inclusive, and highly adaptable hands-on learning system.

In each session we tackle a new adventure, from building and programming robots to boats and amusement parks. Children can also build whatever they want and play general Lego if they don't like technical Lego.


