

#### Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

In our Early Years (Nursery and Reception) children can use our specially designed outdoor area, alongside excellent in-class provision, to explore and develop their learning in the seven areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage:

- Numeracy

- Personal, Social and Emotional Development Literacy
- Communication and Language
- Physical Development

- Understanding of the World

- Expressive Arts and Design

From early in the autumn term, Early Years children access Yoga, PE and Forest School sessions tailored to their age and stage of development.



#### Primary Curriculum Key Stage 1 and 2 (years 1-6)

We understand what children need to know and learn, and our curriculum ensures that every child achieves this and more.

When we teach the curriculum, we ensure that:
Key concepts are repeated
Knowledge organisers and notes are used
Subjects are taught discretely
Low stakes guizzes and end-of unit writing tasks
