Food For Life Donations

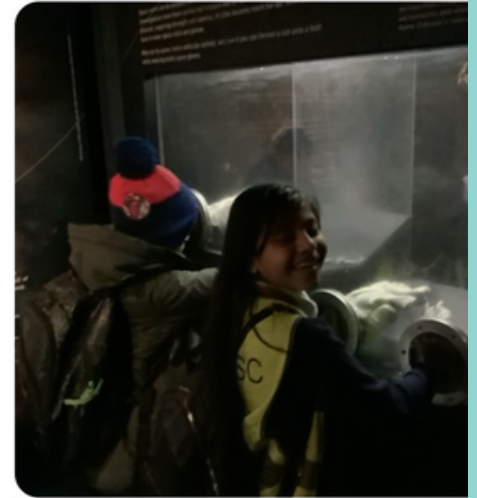
