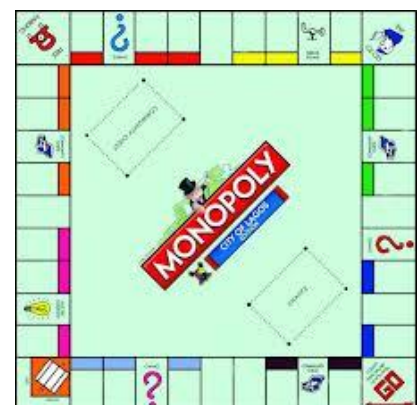
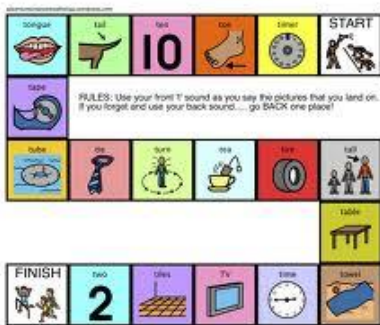


Create your own Maths board game

Your task today is to plan and create a Maths board game which can be played. This means that you have to carefully consider a number of things in order to produce a game which at the end can be played in the classroom.

- What type of game you wish to create – what is the outcome? How do you win?
- The design of the board – how will it look? What is the layout...?
- What pieces will you need to create, e.g. dice, spinners, counters, tokens.
- The rules to go with the board
