How can we develop the use of ambitious vocabulary across the school?

- School Council have brainstormed on strategies teachers can use to help develop our children's vocabulary.
- This is what they thought:
 - Teachers to provide a word a day, specific to all subjects. Children will have opportunities to use the new vocabulary, in lessons, throughout the week.
 - Children would find, subject specific vocabulary, useful and have these on their desk, which would help them in their writing.
 - Morning task could have a different picture each day, a key question such as 'what happens next?' could act as a stimulus to a short writing task.

How can we develop the use of ambitious vocabulary across the school? Cont...

- Teacher models a sentence and children work in groups to uplevel it, using the writing tools they have learned, such as similes, fronted adverbials, time connectives.
- Acronyms to help to remember specific vocabulary such as S O A P
 - S: speaker
 - O: occasion
 - A: audience
 - P: purpose
