Enterprise Education is considered highly important as it provides the skills and the opportunities to become effective citizens, employees, employers, entrepreneurs and leaders of the future. We are an enterprising school at Krishna Avanti, in our management and leadership, the curriculum we offer, the teaching and learning styles and how the school relates to its community. We support the development of enterprising learners by recognising and articulating their skills through various enterprise projects across the school which involve marketing, promoting and setting up their own ideas eg stalls at summer/xmas fairs.

AIMS

At Krishna Avanti Primary School we aim to:

LEARNING AND TEACHING

We aim to build and nurture the concept of enterprise throughout the school in order to equip children with the skills, understanding, confidence and creativity needed for their future working lives. Throughout the year a range of opportunities will be provided to pupils across both Key Stages.

MONITORING AND EVALUATION

This is carried out by the Enterprise Lead and includes:

- Regular meetings with the enterprise team.
- Recommendations and signposting to external sources of support.
- Monitoring and performance by talking to children.
- Observation of learning during enterprise projects.
- Staff meetings and INSET to discuss standards and expectations.
- Evaluation of extra-curricular activities, e.g. Summer and Christmas fairs and events in the wider community.

PUPIL ASSESSMENT

Assessment of pupil work and progress is ongoing through pupil observations, appropriate questioning and evaluation of any recorded work produced during enterprise projects. This not only informs future planning but provides information for a pupil's records, parent discussions and annual reports.
