Chapter One

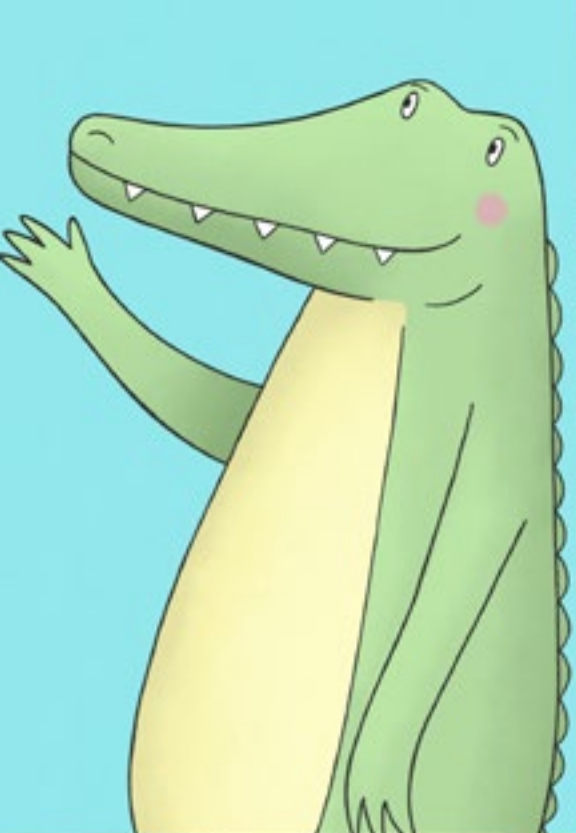
Me and My Friends

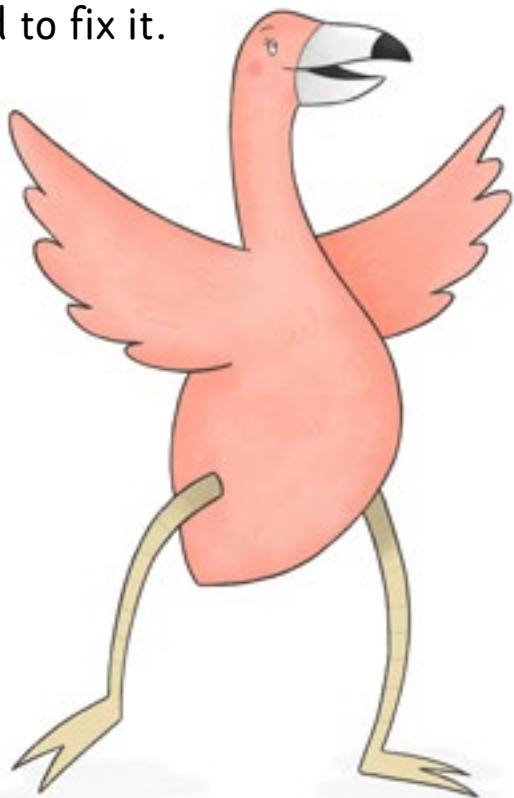
Frank Frog is the sort of friend you go to when you want to laugh your socks off.

"I'm looking for a present for Fancy," I said.

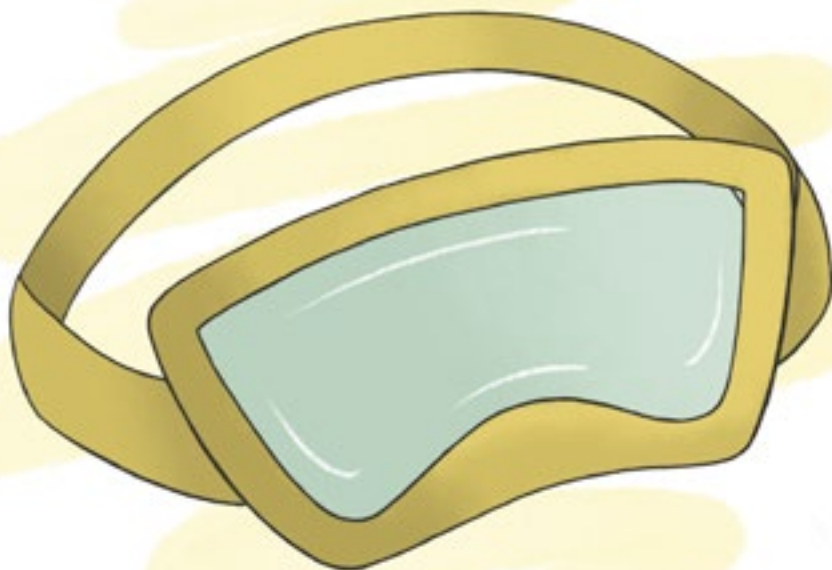
"The party is today, Ozzy! Let me guess... You forgot to get her something?" said Connor.

"Well, that's your fault," Connor snapped. "You better head back into the rainforest and look for something there."

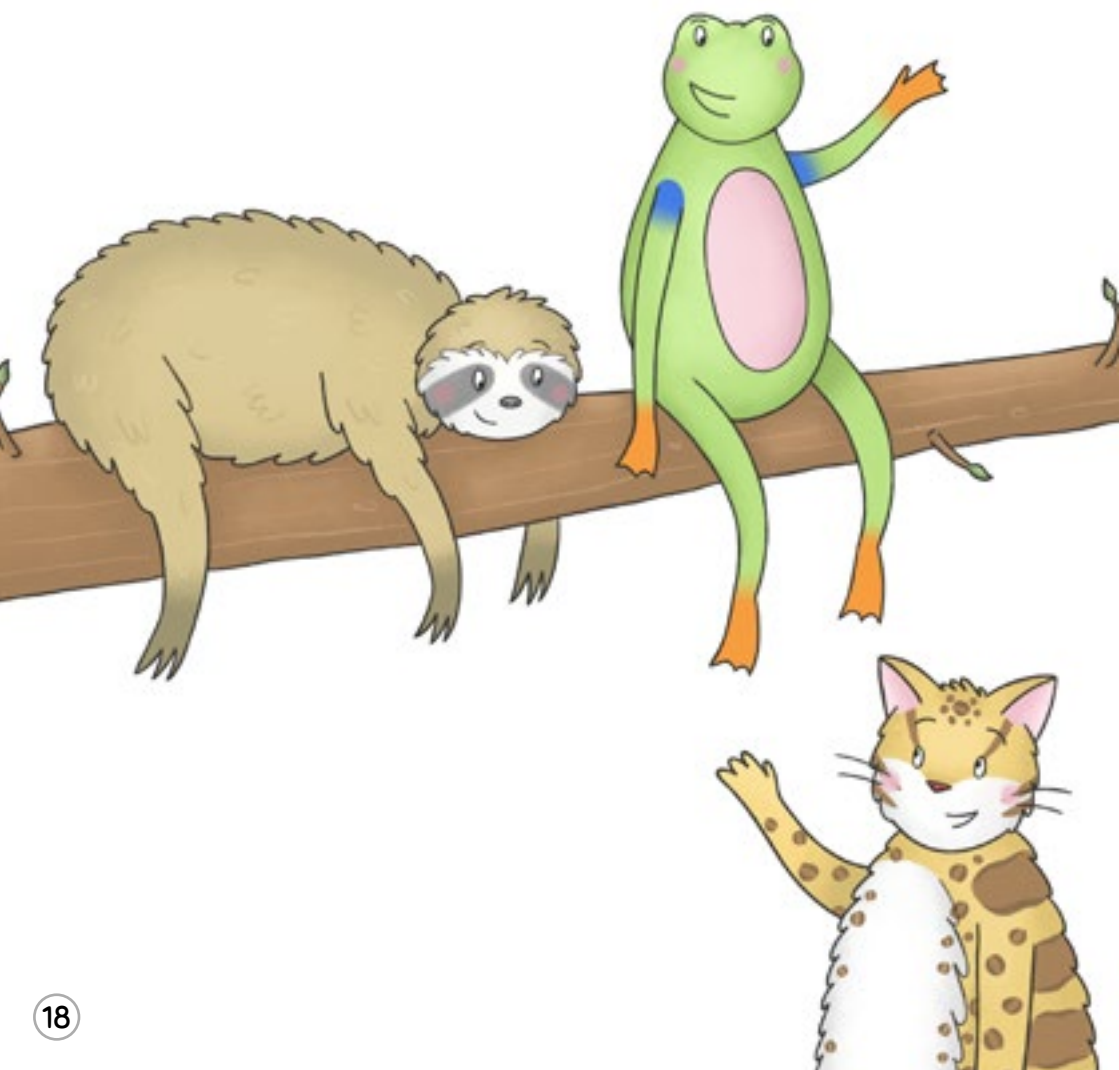




I went back into the rainforest to look for a present. Both Solomon Sloth and Frank Frog were hanging out in the trees.

"Solomon! Frank! I forgot to get Fancy a birthday present. I need some help!" I shouted.



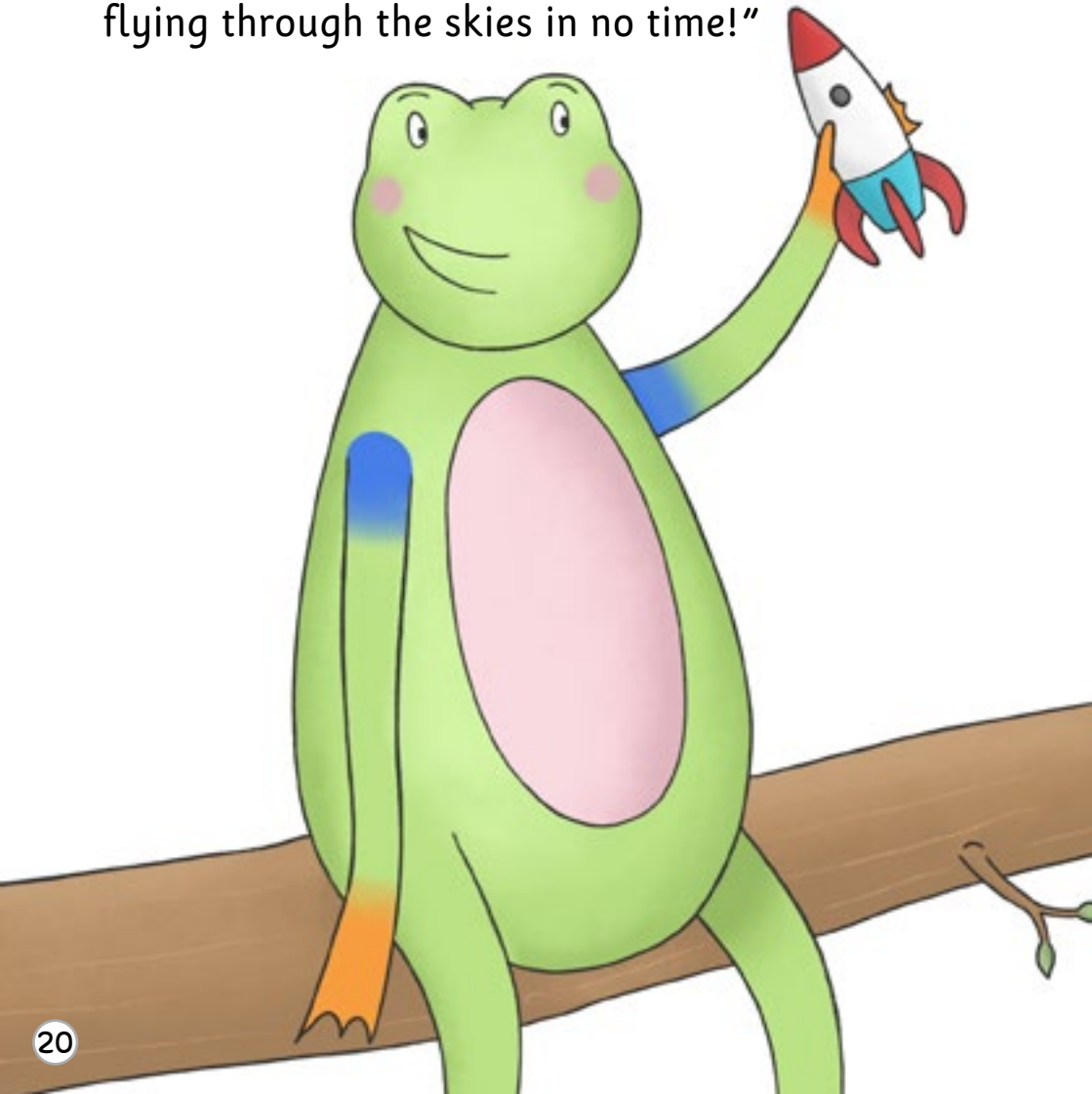
"Well, I got Fancy this old potato. Isn't it neat?" said Solomon. He held up a potato that was small and spotty.

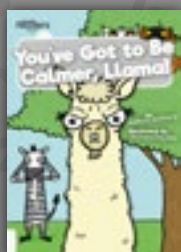
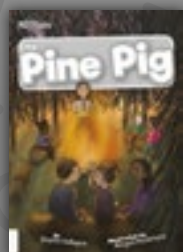
