
TOP TIPS FOR HELPING YOUR CHILD TO READ:

- Allow children time to break down unfamiliar words into units of sound and then encourage children to string these sounds together to create the word.
- Encourage your child to point out any focus phonics when they are used.
- Read through the book more than once to grow confidence.
- Ask simple questions about the text to assess understanding.
- Encourage children to use illustrations as prompts.

"My Stormship and the Cloud Hunters are strong," said Ray. "We will be back in less than a day."




The Stormship set sail right away. It was the Cloud Hunters' job to trap clouds and



The clouds and lightning will be sent down to Bray, so the people can have their lights on again.




The wind was hard. The Stormship swayed to the right.






The spray from the rain hit them hard. There was a sudden loud sound.
