

- Day 10 Travel back to Delhi and fly back to UK




2 Day Trip to Jaipur

- Learn the history of the arts & architecture that Jaipur is famous for




Culture

- Spend time with the local elephants!











Architecture

Taste


- Eat Jaipuri Cuisine in an authentic environment!

- Travel to Vrindavan from Agra in the evening








5-Day Trip to Vrindavan & Govardhan









Darshan

Accommodation

- Jaipur hotel accommodation (still to be booked).
 Looking at 4* hotels in the centre of Jaipur
- Vrindavan 1 night at MVT guesthouse next to ISKCON Vrindavan and 4 nights at Govardhan Retreat Centre. All rooms have AC and en-suites. Comfortable & clean
- Rooms will have 2 people occupancy





Food (Prashad)

- Food will be provided by one of our reputable agencies – Love Braj who will cook the majority of meals and provide us with packed lunches where necessary
- Snacks will be available if necessary
- Food is cooked in a safe and clean environment.
- Ethos friendly prashad
- Bottled water will be used at all times during meal times, students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles for the trip that they can carry around



Safety

- Given the complexities of an international trip, we are in the process of assessing all potential risks across transport, accommodation and activities.
- A 1:5 ratio of teachers to students will be maintained throughout the trip.
- An on-site doctor will stay with us for the duration of the trip to address health-related concerns, administer necessary care, and ensure the overall well-being of the children.
- The retreat team will be meeting with school staff in advance to go over expectations.
- Members of our team (and some teachers) are First Aid trained.



What do we expect from students?

- Students to listen and respect all Avanti rules, so that the programme runs without disruption and everyone is kept safe.
- To be respectful and supportive of the retreat team, school staff & volunteers that will be attending, as well as their peers.
- To be respectful of the locals and be open to understanding a different culture/language from the one they may be used to.
- Dress code We do not expect anyone to wear full Indian clothes, but we do ask that as we are going to holy places they should dress appropriately and comfortably



What do we expect from parents?

- If interested, please register by completing the initial form as found in the letter.
- To secure your child's place, please make the £100 non refunbdable deposit once made available in ParentPay/Arbor where a monthly payment plan is available.
- To fill in the necessary contact and medical forms when shared by schools after registration.
- To support children in preparing their luggage and passports for the retreat. A recommended list of items to pack to will be provided nearer to the retreat date.
- To ensure that students arrive at school on-time when leaving for the retreat and that students have the means to get home on their return to school.
